The drive will begin in Rockville at the Billie Creek Village Inn Parking Lot. Be sure to tell them you are with the Indy Miata Club and they will give you a discount to \$3.00 per person to enter the village. We will leave promptly at 2:30 p.m. from the Inn parking lot.

For those that want to caravan from Indy to Rockville, we will meet at the Avon Ritters at 12:30 p.m. and leave promptly at 12:45. The Ritters is on US 36 West between Avon and Danville (West on US36, 3rd stop light after US267). We will arrive in Rockville in plenty of time for people to enjoy the village before leaving the Billie Creek Inn parking lot at 2:30.

The tour will include 7-10 covered bridges, a stop in Bridgeton to see the mill and rebuilding of the bridge (the original bridge was destroyed by arson last year) and will end at Turkey Run State Park. There is an entrance fee of \$4 per car, we are working on a discount so ask at the gate. You can enjoy a drive through the park if you wish and then enjoy a buffet dinner at the Turkey Run Inn at 5:00 p.m. The buffet is approximately \$10 per person including tip.
